## Best Overall nutribullet

nutribullet Smart Touch Blender Combo

The [nutribullet Smart Touch](#) is the blender dreams are made of! It takes the confusion out of blending frozen drinks, purées, soups and smoothies with pre-set buttons for each category. With the Smart Touch's high-performing 1,500-watt motor, you can easily crush ice and slice through tough ingredients. No more opening the lid, stirring around the ingredients, hitting pulse and checking on repeat—the Smart Touch has got it covered!

The high-capacity ventilated pitcher lets steam escape, which is key for blending warm soups and purées without the top popping off. Plus, the locking lid and easy-pour spout make pouring clean and easy. When you're done blending, the pitcher is dishwasher safe. In addition to the 64-ounce pitcher, this blender comes with a 32-ounce cup, a 20-ounce cup and two to-go lids.

The nutribullet food processor's large-capacity bowl and feeding chute let you prep large quantities of food cleanly, and it comes with a variety of attachments and accessories: a chopping blade, a dough blade, a spiralizer disc and two reversible slice/shred discs. The dishwasher-safe bowl, lid and blades are all bisphenol A (BPA)-free and made of high-quality materials, ensuring durability and long-lasting use.

## What to Look for When Buying a nutribullet

When deciding which nutribullet is right for you, think about what exactly you’ll be using it for. Will you be making smoothies with frozen fruit? Juicing whole fruits and vegetables? Puréeing cooked foods? Once you’ve determined your needs, consider the following points:

- **Power:** If you'll regularly be processing tough ingredients like ice, nuts, seeds, firm vegetables or frozen veggies, you'll want a motor with higher wattage.
- **Capacity:** You may be able to get away with a classic nutribullet model if you're only using it for one or two people. Bigger families require a bigger blender, like the Smart Touch.
- **Accessories:** Some nutribullet models come with extra cups, lids and other attachments. If the blender you're looking at doesn't come with everything you want, you can [purchase additional accessories](#) on the nutribullet website.

## How We Found the Best nutribullets

As shopping experts, our only job is to help you find a winning product. We start with the research and reporting basics—what products are made of, what they look like and how much they cost—to ensure that we're only recommending the buys that are worth your time and money. Then, we research the features that speak to the product's quality, taking advice from industry insiders and subject matter experts on what makes a product a smart value (or worthy of a splurge). Finally, we do the work of combing through user reviews to see how real people interact with the product, and if it stands up to the test.

## FAQ

### What's the difference between nutribullet and nutribullet Plus?

The standard nutribullet has a 600-watt motor with a two-pronged blade while the nutribullet Plus has a powerful 1,200-watt motor and a four-pronged extractor blade. This means that the nutribullet Plus can easily tackle harder, tougher ingredients (like beets and squash), resulting in smoother purées in a fraction of the time. While the nutribullet Plus is the pricier of the two picks, it also includes a 32-ounce cup and two 24-ounce cups. The classic nutribullet only comes with one 24-ounce cup and an 18-ounce cup.

### Which Nutribullet can crush ice?

The nutribullet and the nutribullet Plus are both capable of crushing ice, though the Plus is able to crush ice more quickly and into a finer size, thanks to its more powerful motor.
